Follow 5 Safe Cycling Rules and Keep Your Tour Accident-Free!

- 1 Bicycles should use the road in principle, Keep to left, Pedestrians first on the sidewalk
- 2 Obey traffic light and stop sign at the crossroad to confirm safety
- 3 Turn on the light in the nighttime
- 4 No drunk-driving
- 5 Wear a helmet

Wear a Helmet for Cycling

In case of bicycle accidents, the death rate for unhelmeted riders is about 3 times higher than for those wearing a helmet. For your safety make sure to wear a helmet for cycling.

Get Bicycle Liability Insurance

In Okayama City, it is mandatory for all cyclists to have liability insurance to be compensated in the event of an accident. Your automobile insurance policy may include optional coverage for bicycle accidents. Please check your insurance status.
