Okayama Korakukan Night Junior High School (Public Night Junior High School) is...



The Public Night Junior High School is a public junior high school that provides the night classes from 5:30pm to 8:45pm to ensure access to compulsory education for people who are over 15-year-olds who are equivalent to the students completed compulsory education. It also serves those who graduated from junior high school without receiving adequate education for various reasons, such as school absenteeism, as well as foreign nationals who did not receive compulsory education in their home countries.



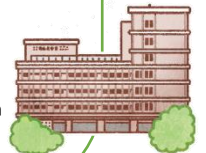
To provide all students with the opportunities to learn and achieve self-realization, the first Night Class (Public Night Junior High School) was established in April, 2025 in Okayama Municipal Okayama Korakukan Junior High School.
If you or someone you know would like to enroll in the Night Class, please join the Orientation for New Students.

What is the Public Night Junior High School ...?

- It is a public junior high school which is equivalent to the regular (daytime) junior high school.
- You have classes starting in the evening (from 5:30pm to 8:45pm) from Monday to Friday.
- You have 4-hour classes every day from Monday to Friday and study all subjects for junior high school.
- You will receive a junior high school diploma once you complete all in curriculum in Night Junior High School.
- It is a **place for relearning compulsory education** for people who have not graduated from junior high school yet or who were not able to receive adequate education at school for various reasons.

Eligibility for Enrollment

- Over 15-year-olds who are equivalent to the students completed compulsory education
- People who have not graduated from junior high school yet or who were not able to receive adequate education for various reasons even though they have graduated.
(Foreign nationals in the same situations can also enroll.)
- People who live in Okayama City
- People who live in the cities or towns signed an agreement on Night Junior High School with Okayama City
